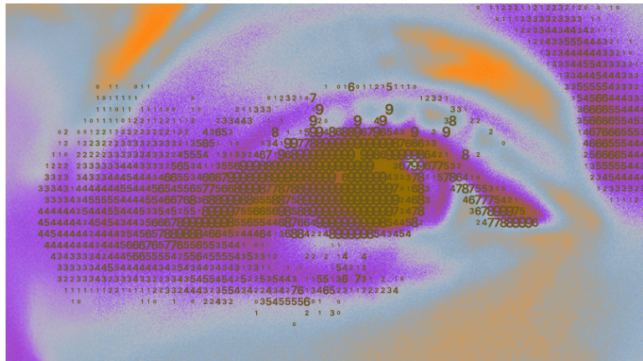

This September, the Southbank Centre's unmissable 75th anniversary celebrations continue with *Goalhanger: The Rest Is Fest* (4 – 6 Sep). For the first time, all of Goalhanger's chart-topping podcasts are hitting the stage for a weekend of more than 20 thrilling shows, Q&As and panels exploring the stories shaping our world in this landmark collaboration between Europe's largest arts centre and one of the world's largest independent podcast producers. The action kicks off in the Royal Festival Hall with the live premiere of *The Rest Is Football: Bursting Onto the Stage* (4 Sep). **Stanley Tucci** is joined by **Gary Lineker** for deliciously entertaining discussion about film, food and everything in between in *Stanley Tucci: Film, Food and Me* (6 Sep), while *The Rest is History's* **Tom Holland** and *The Rest is Entertainment's* **Marina Hyde** join forces for a whistlestop tour of Regency England's most glamorous, drama-fuelled women in *The Real Housewives of Regency England* (6 Sep). The weekend culminates with *The Rest Is Quiz* (6 Sep), bringing together the stars of all the Goalhanger shows for one epic quiz night.

London's newest celebration of technology and creativity, *Creative Intelligence*, arrives at the Southbank Centre this autumn (11 – 13 Sep), exploring how artists, digital innovation, and AI are actively reshaping our world. The weekend kicks off with the *Creative Intelligence Summit* (11 Sep), an essential gathering for culture makers, creative entrepreneurs, and technological innovators. Across the weekend, audiences are invited to get their hands dirty and explore the world-changing innovations of creative entrepreneurs. Highlights include; *Listening Session with Holly Herndon* (11 Sep), a cutting-edge evening of electronic music, *Kevin Peter He: Vestige* (12 Sep), a magnetic live dance-theatre work, and an array of free technology expos and installations across the Southbank Centre site that showcase the artists at the forefront of digital innovation (11 – 13 Sep).

Ahead of the Classical Music Autumn/Winter 26/27 Opening Week, *Playing With Fire: An Immersive Odyssey with Yuja Wang* takes orchestral music beyond the concert hall with a multisensory, virtual concert experience (9 Sep 2026 – 3 Jan 2027). Audiences are invited to roam freely around an avatar of Yuja performing a dazzling selection of classic works on a real, self-playing Steinway Spirio piano.

The Southbank Centre's forward looking anniversary year continues with **Letters to the Future** (18 – 20 Sep), a major weekend festival bringing together leading thinkers of tomorrow to confront the most pivotal issues that are shaping our future. Trailblazing content producer **Amelia Dimoldenberg** (18 Sep) chairs *The Future of Digital Media*, an urgent panel decoding the explosive growth and future landscape of content creation. Bestselling author **Rebecca F Kuang** (19 Sep) curates *The Future of Education*, a discussion unpacking how AI is redefining education, pop star and actor **Olly Alexander** (19 Sep) explores *The Future Of Queer Storytelling*, environmental campaigner and award-winning ornithologist **Dr Mya-Rose Craig** (20 Sep) explores what faces humanity if the climate crisis recedes in *Beyond the Climate Crisis*, while broadcaster and author **Ash Sarkar** (20 Sep) dissects the future of human relationships in the inaugural *Southbank Centre Lecture*. The weekend also includes a programme of free events, platforming up-and-coming new talent and DJs pushing the boundaries of sound.

Classical music returns to the Southbank Centre for the Autumn/Winter 26/27 season with an exceptional Opening Week highlighting the sonic and emotional range of the artform. Iconic minimalist composer **Steve Reich**'s 90th birthday is celebrated in a series of concerts featuring an unmissable collaboration between **London Sinfonietta** and Radiohead's **Jonny Greenwood** (27 Sep), an innovative performance of Reich's *Music for 18 Musicians* from **Paraorchestra** (27 Sep), and more. **Julia Wolfe**'s epic, semi-staged elegy to the victims of New York's 1911 Triangle Shirtwaist Factory fire, *Fire in My Mouth*, receives its London premiere (22 Sep), and new Southbank Centre resident artists **Jean ROUNDEAU** (27 Sep) and **Pekka Kuusisto** (25 Sep) take to the Queen Elizabeth Hall for their season debuts.

Queer nightlife innovators Duckie celebrate the legacy of Shirley Bassey in *THIS IS MY LIFE* (20 Sep), an unmissable variety show featuring **Shirley Classy**, **David McAlmont**, **Neil Bartlett** and **Rhys' Pieces**. Before the performance, **David Hoyle**,

David McAlmont and **Rupert Smith** share the stage to discuss why the queer connection to women musicians is so fierce in *Why Do Benders Love Divas?* (20 Sep).

Anish Kapoor's landmark return to the Hayward Gallery continues, featuring works from many of Kapoor's iconic series alongside dramatic recent works (16 Jun – 18 Oct). The Hayward Gallery gets a new look this autumn with *September*, a vibrant painting by Swiss artist **Renée Levi** that transforms its iconic Brutalist façade (23 Sept – 15 Nov). This bold co-commission by the Hayward Gallery and Audemars Piguet Contemporary marks Levi's first large-scale public artwork in the UK.
