Frequently Asked Questions

When is the live stream?

Thursday 17 October at 11am on Southbank Centre's YouTube channel (youtube.com/user/SouthbankCentre). Registration is required.

What is the format of the event?

Julian Clary and David Roberts appear live at Southbank Centre, and the event is filmed and live-streamed via the Southbank Centre YouTube channel for you and your pupils to enjoy.

How do I register for the event?

Registration is free. Fill in the form here via the Southbank Centre website to register for the live stream and the accompanying education pack. [Registration is available to all schools via this link](#). This event is best suited to pupils in Key Stage 2.

Do I have to pay?

No, registration and streaming is free, and if you register, you receive an education pack to accompany the event.

What tech equipment will I need?

You need a working internet connection and access to YouTube.

We recommend that you use a projector and a screen, or a smart whiteboard, to display the stream. You also need some speakers that are linked and are the appropriate size to your classroom/hall.

Some schools block access to YouTube, so you may need to work with your school technician in advance to access the site easily on the day.

Will I require help from a technician?

We don't think you will, but you may require some simple help in terms of firewalls and sound – see question above

How can I test in advance to see if it works?

When you receive the link, you can go to the web page. There will be a holding slide displaying the name of the event along with the date. This holding slide turns into the live stream on the day.

You can test your speakers by watching any other YouTube channel.

What happens if there is a technical hitch at Southbank Centre on the day, or a delay?
