In January 2017, Southbank Centre presented this iconic Scorsese work at Royal Festival Hall with a live score for the first time ever. The brooding, shifting chords, ominous drum beat and a soaring saxophone melody in Bernard Herrmann's last film score, delivered the night before he died, provides an eloquent, nightmarish texture to Scorsese's hellish portrait of 70s Manhattan.
