#### Need to know

#### Getting to and from New Year's Eve Spectacular

The Southbank Centre site closes at 3pm on Saturday 31 December. It reopens at 6.30pm for Golden Dining and Silver Dining Spectacular ticket holders, and 7pm for other NYE Spectacular and Roof Garden Spectacular ticket holders (including those with street food included).

Travel to Southwark Underground station and follow the Blue route (see map below) to our site, or travel to Waterloo Underground station and walk to the site via Cornwall Road and follow the Orange route (no access via Concert Hall Approach). Most local bridges crossing the Thames will be closed.

Roads around the immediate area are closed from 5pm and do not reopen until around 4am, so please do not drive to the site.

Please allow plenty of time for your arrival as we expect the area to be heavily congested with footfall and there is no guarantee you will be able to enter our site after 8pm, due to cordons that are in place for the London New Year's Eve fireworks. No refunds will be given.

Upon arrival it is likely you will need to wait a while in the queue outside, so make sure you wrap up warm! There will be a cloakroom available once you're inside.

Bookers with access requirements can enter via Concert Hall Approach, follow the Green route (see map below) and should make themselves known to the team when they arrive at the queue.

We also have a quiet space available on Level 6 of the Royal Festival Hall throughout the night.

We advise you not to leave *New Year's Eve Spectacular* until after 12.30am, as the area will be highly congested with people watching the fireworks. *New Year's Eve Spectacular* finishes at 2.30am.

Waterloo station is also likely to be extremely busy before and after midnight, with long queues expected. If possible, please use alternative stations.

#### All ticket holders

You will not be able to enter the Southbank Centre's local area without a ticket – an e-ticket, paper ticket or a printout of your e-ticket. There will be ticket checks along the Orange and Blue routes (see map below) where you need to show your ticket. When you reach our site, please make sure you enter via the gate specified on your ticket.

In line with the London New Year's Eve fireworks, the Southbank Centre has special security procedures in place for the duration of the event, for the safety of our visitors. These include mandatory bag searches.

Food and drink bought off the premises may not be taken onto the Southbank Centre site and will be confiscated.

On arrival, all ticket holders are given event information, a drinks token for your free glass of fizz and a wristband.

This wristband identifies the access you will have around the site and what type of dining you have (where applicable). For visitors whose ticket includes street-food dining, your wristband will be marked once you've used it to claim your food.

The wristband you are given is also unique to the area where you can watch the fireworks. All fireworks viewing areas are open from 11.30pm – 12.30am.\*

#### **Golden and Silver Dining Spectacular** ticket holders


You may enter the site from 6.30pm and should be seated by 7.15pm, ready for dinner to be served at 7.30pm.
