All ticket holders

You will not be able to enter our site without a ticket – a paper ticket, a printout of your e-ticket, or your e-ticket on your phone. Please make sure you enter via the Gate specified on your ticket.

In line with the Mayor of London's New Year's Eve Fireworks, Southbank Centre has special security procedures in place for the duration of the event for the safety of our visitors. These include mandatory bag searches.

Food and drink bought off the premises may not be taken onto the Southbank Centre site.

On arrival, all ticket holders will be given a wristband, event information and a drinks token for your free glass of fizz.

Food and drink is available to purchase throughout the building all night. All drinks will be served in plastic glasses.

If you are a Member, please bring your Membership card with you to allow yourself and one other into the Members' Cafe-Bar.

Getting to and from New Year's Eve Spectacular

Southbank Centre's site will close at 3pm on Monday 31 December, with entry at 6.30pm for Dining Spectacular and 7pm for Riverside Spectacular and Balcony Spectacular ticket holders only.

Travel to Southwark tube station and follow the Green firework route to our site, or travel to Waterloo station and walk to the site via Cornwall Road (no access via Concert Hall Approach). The Golden Jubilee Bridges will be closed.

Roads around the immediate area are closed from 5pm and do not reopen until circa 4am, so please do not drive to the site.

There is no guarantee you will be able to get onto our site after 8pm due to cordons in place for the Mayor of London's New Year's Eve Fireworks. No refunds will be given.

We advise you not to leave New Year's Eve Spectacular until after 12.30am, as the area will be very congested with people watching the fireworks.

Balcony Spectacular ticket holders

On arrival, you will receive a unique wristband that will give you access to Royal Festival Hall's Level 5 Balcony, which is open 10pm – 2am.

Dining Spectacular ticket holders

Please arrive from 6.30pm and enter via Gate D. You should be seated by 7.15pm ready for dinner to be served at 7.30pm.

There is one sitting, so if you are not seated by 7.30pm we cannot guarantee that you will be served all three courses. The meal will last approximately 90 minutes.

You will have use of your table all night. Tables are pre-allocated and we cannot make changes on the night.

On arrival, you will receive a unique wristband that will give you access to Weston Roof Pavilion on Level 6 of Royal Festival Hall, which will be open from 11.30pm until 12.30am, to view the fireworks.
