Need to know

Getting to and from New Year's Eve Spectacular

Southbank Centre's site will close at 3pm on Tuesday 31 December, with entry at 6.30pm for Balcony Spectacular and Ultimate Spectacular ticket holders, and 7pm for Riverside Spectacular and Roof Garden Spectacular ticket holders only.

Travel to Southwark Underground station and follow the Green firework route (see map below) to our site, or travel to Waterloo Underground station and walk to the site via Cornwall Road (no access via Concert Hall Approach). The Golden Jubilee Bridges will be closed.

Roads around the immediate area are closed from 5pm and do not reopen until circa 4am, so please do not drive to the site.

There is no guarantee you will be able to enter our site after 8pm, due to cordons that are in place for the Mayor of London's New Year's Eve Fireworks. No refunds will be given.

We advise you not to leave New Year's Eve Spectacular until after 12.30am, as the area will be highly congested with people watching the fireworks.

All ticket holders

You will not be able to enter Southbank Centre's local area without a ticket – a paper ticket, a printout of your e-ticket, or your e-ticket on your phone. There will be a ticket check at Cornwall Road, where you need to show your ticket that clearly displays the Southbank Centre logo. When you reach our site, please make sure you enter via the gate specified on your ticket.

In line with the Mayor of London's New Year's Eve Fireworks, Southbank Centre has special security procedures in place for the duration of the event, for the safety of our visitors. These include mandatory bag searches.

Food and drink bought off the premises may not be taken onto the Southbank Centre site.

On arrival, all ticket holders are given a wristband, event information and a drinks token for your free glass of fizz.

The wristband you are given is unique to the area where you can watch the London Fireworks (Riverside and Riverside Terrace, Levels 1 & 2 / Roof Garden, Queen Elizabeth Hall / Balcony Terrace, Level 5, Royal Festival Hall / Weston Roof Pavilion, Level 6, Green Side, Royal Festival Hall). All fireworks viewing areas are open from 11.30pm – 12.30am.

Food and drink is available to purchase throughout the building all night. All drinks are served in plastic glasses. (Please note all our plastics are compostable where possible).

If you are a Member, please bring your Membership card with you to allow yourself and one other into the Members' Cafe-Bar.

Don't forget to dress to impress!

Balcony Spectacular and Ultimate Spectacular ticket holders (dining tickets)

You should be seated by 7.15pm, ready for dinner to be served at 7.30pm.

There is one sitting. If you are not seated by 7.30pm, we cannot guarantee that you will be served all three courses. The meal lasts approximately 90 minutes.

You have use of your table all night. Tables are preallocated and we cannot make changes on the night.


