CEREMONY GUESTS

Welcome to the Virgin TV British Academy Television Awards 2017. The event is set to be a glamorous and star-filled evening celebrating the very best in television at the spectacular Royal Festival Hall, Southbank Centre. We look forward to you joining us.

ARRIVALS

On Sunday 14th May there will be over 1500 guests travelling to the Royal Festival Hall so please allow plenty of time for your journey.

The doors to the venue will open at 16.30 and close at 17.00. If you arrive after 17.00 you will **not** be admitted.

Your ticket will allow you access to the red carpet before entering the venue. There will be a bar area for guests to wait in until the doors to the auditorium are opened. You will need to enter the red carpet via Queen Elizabeth Hall slip road off Belvedere Road.

Due to the large numbers of people arriving at the venue, re-entry to the theatre is not permitted.

CEREMONY

The doors to the auditorium will open at 18.30 and the ceremony will begin at 19.00. These times are approximate and subject to change on the day.

The ceremony will last approximately 2.5 hours. There will be no access to the public areas of the Royal Festival Hall after the ceremony.

To allow all participants to enjoy the evening we would ask that you respect the privacy of your fellow guests and refrain from approaching others for autographs or photographs at any time.

RECORDING

The ceremony will be televised by BBC One. For the purposes of the televised production, please ensure that you sit in the seat allocated to you.

By using this ticket you agree to waive all rights to the use by BAFTA and its assigns and licensees of your name, image and any performance that you may give, and agree that your name, image and any performance may be broadcast, printed or

otherwise reproduced, used or exhibited (by radio, television, print or any other media) without payment

It is essential that all guests arrive promptly as there is no admittance once recording has started.

DRESS CODE

The event dress code is smart.

We regret that cloakroom facilities are not available for this event so please do not bring large bags with you.

SMOKING

There is no smoking in any areas of the Royal Festival Hall

REFRESHMENTS

There will be a bar available inside the Royal Festival Hall to purchase refreshments

SECURITY

In the interest of all our guests, security will be extremely tight. It is essential that you bring your ticket with you on the night and keep it on you at all times. Bag searches will be in operation.

PHOTOGRAPHY

Photography is not permitted during the ceremony apart from by the official BAFTA photographers.
