

## Create your own Sprite

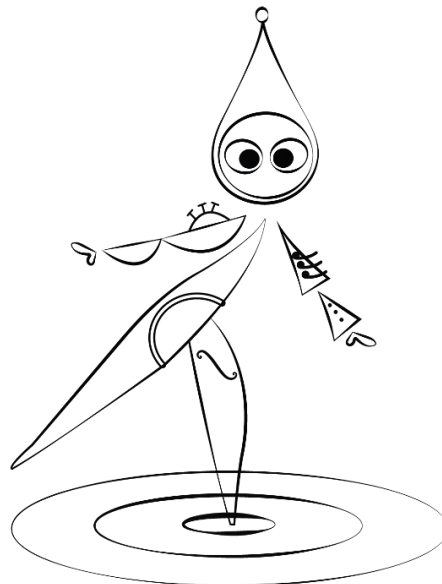
You will need:

- 4 cut-out pages  
(Stand, Sprite, Instruments I, and Instruments II)
- Canvas page
- Scissors
- Glue

### In a nutshell

- You'll be creating a pop-up card with instruments from all families of the orchestra and Sprite rising in the middle.
- All pieces with little scissor indicators have to be cut, folded both ways, creased and unfolded.
- Matching color flaps have to be pasted to the corresponding color in other pieces with the glue covering the colored portions.
- After pasting every piece, the canvas should be gently folded –as if closing a book with the glued pieces inside– and opened again to continue.

**This might be enough for you to figure it out or you can follow the numbered steps.**



1. Set aside your Sprite and Instrument pages for now.
2. Find your Stand page. Cut out each of the stand pieces by cutting along the solid black lines.
3. Fold and crease the cutouts along the dotted lines. Fold and crease them in the other direction as well. Unfold them when you're done.
4. You should have three pieces for the stand:
  - a. The 'Outer' piece with purple base flaps.
  - b. The 'Inner' piece with green base flaps.
  - c. The 'Connector' piece with blue flaps on either end.
5. Find your Canvas page. Fold and crease it along the dotted line in both directions. Unfold it when you're done.
6. Find the Outer stand piece with purple base flaps, then find the purple indicators on your Canvas page. Paying close attention to the black guide lines on your canvas, line up the Outer stand piece with the black guide lines so that the purple base flaps cover the purple indicators. Glue the purple base flaps to the purple indicators.
7. Do the same with the green base flaps so that they cover the green indicators.

**Check your work:** It's important that the stand pieces be aligned to the black guide lines on the Canvas page. Try to gently close and open the Canvas page like a book with the stand pieces in the middle. The Canvas page should fold shut easily.

1. You should have the Inner and Outer stand pieces glued to the page aligned to the guide lines.
2. On the Inner stand piece, find the blue and yellow tabs at the top of the piece. On the Outer stand piece, find the yellow marked areas at the top of the piece.
3. Glue the yellow tabs on the Inner piece to the yellow marked areas at the top of the Outer piece. The blue sections should be facing up.

**Check your work:** Gently try to close and open the Canvas page like before. The stand pieces should fold flat as you close the Canvas page. If they don't, check that the bases of the stand pieces are lined up to the black guide lines.

1. Now find the Connector piece. Fold the blue tabs flat so the blue sections point down.
2. Line up the blue sections on the Connector piece to the blue sections on the Inner stand piece.
3. Glue each of the blue tabs on the Connector to the blue sections

Now you're ready to make your Sprite using the template or making your own:

1. Decorate Sprite using coloring pencils and other materials at hand.
2. Cut out Sprite.
3. Fold and crease along the dotted line.
4. Use a bit of glue to attach Sprite's body to the top of the Connector piece with the dotted line of Sprite in the same direction as the dotted line of the canvas.
5. Attach the head by sliding the tab into the slit at the top of Sprite's body and gluing the tab to the underside of Sprite.
6. Add the finishing touches to make Sprite your own.

**TIP:** You can use the pieces that represent each of the instrument families and glue them to Sprite or create an orchestra on the canvas.
