THE IMMERSIVE EXHIBITION

Southbank Centre presents an immersive experience of Tove Jansson's Moominland.

Adventures in Moominland is an immersive experience for all ages exploring internationally beloved Moomin stories by Tove Jansson such as *Comet in Moominland* (1946), *Finn Family Moomintroll* (1948) and *Moomin Midwinter* (1957).

Visitors are invited to clamber through forests, huddle in caves and set sail on the high seas to find the Moomin family. Within these unique scenes they uncover original archive material, including beautiful drawings and sketches by the artist and author Tove Jansson, unlocking the world behind the creation of her stories and characters.

This exciting and visually rich exhibition explores the influence of the Finnish landscape within the Moomin books: the Nordic winters, the balmy summers, the light and the dark. These themes are all vividly present in Tove's illustrations of the landscape of Moominvalley - and Tove's own island of Klovaharu is particularly important.

Written against a backdrop of political and socio-economic change in Finland, these tales were heavily influenced by Tove's personal relationships with family, friends and lovers, which defined both the narrative and character development. Her friends, enemies, fears and hopes often found themselves manifested in these complex, emotional stories.

This multi-layered experience explores both the fun and frivolous elements of the Moomins in parallel with the deeper themes considered in Jansson's work in a manner appropriate for adventurers of all ages.
